Activity Fees

Please be aware of the Activity & Transport Fees for each activity and bring suitable cash along on the day to cover the expenses. Please bring an Opal card, to tap-on and off at the train station!

For some events, Activity Fees may be lower; typically these price differences are indicated on the activity. To take advantage of this, please indicate in the booking form: your Age, and whether you hold a valid Concession Card or Companion Card for the duration of this program. If you have indicated that you have an eligible Companion Card, please ensure you bring it along to the activity to avoid any complications on the day. For 1:1 participants without a Companion Card, entry fee for support staff will be additionally charged.

Food and spending money

Please bring a packed lunch and afternoon tea, or otherwise bring a suitable amount of spending money to purchase food during the activity. Please note this program is a nut-free environment as some participants may have allergies.

Medication

Medication must be provided in a Webster Pack with a completed and signed Medication Chart for each day attended. Failure to provide medication in this manner may preclude attendance on the day.

Pick up and Drop offs

Transport to and from the activity can be provided for those who require it to participate. Please indicate in the booking form, which activities you will be requiring a pick-up and/or drop-off to be arranged. There will be a flat charge of 10kms from your NDIS package, however if outside the 10kms we will charge accordingly.

Group Transport

For activities that use PA vans or staff cars, the cost of transports will be divided across participants, based on the number of attendees and the number of vehicles used. These costs will be charged to your NDIS Package.

Cancellations

We require 7 days' notice for cancellations, otherwise the cost of supports may be charged to your NDIS package. For activities that require pre-booking tickets, by selecting the activity in the booking form, you agree to pay the indicated cost (Activity Fee) of these tickets — even if you revise attendance at the activity. Cancellation notices may be provided through your nominated contact.
